44 participants worked at five project sites 66 bags of trash removed and approximately 48 miles of land treated

Projects & Outcomes

Faith Valley Meadow Restoration

• 3 Beaver Dam Analogs worked on with approximately 500 willow trimmings added to the structures

Faith Valley Dispersed Camping Area Cleanup

• 6 bags of trash (~ 80 lbs.) collected along an 18-mile stretch in Faith Valley

West Fork Carson River and Dispersed Camping Areas Cleanup

• 24 bags of trash (~ 100 lbs.) and approximately 10 lbs. of recyclables collected along a 3-mile stretch in Woodfords Canyon

Adopt-A-Highway Cleanups

- 36 bags of trash (~ 770 lbs.) and approximately 110 lbs. of recyclables collected along 27 miles of Highway 88 from the turnoff to Monitor Pass to Turtle Rock Park and Highway 89 through Hope Valley
